When used in a program of high fertility and managed soil P.H., it will spread and withstand wear, traffic and mechanical damage. Mix with fine fescues and or perennial ryegrasses in cooler climates and at the rate of 5-20% with turf type tall fescue in transition zone for added sod strength and wear tolerance.

Geographical Adaptation: **GOLDRUSH** will thrive throughout the range of Kentucky bluegrasses adaptation. It has adaptability in the Northern quarter of the transition zone under appropriate management.

Features: **GOLDRUSH** features density, and offers rhizomatous repair of damaged areas for the customer who unquestionably wants the highest quality obtainable.
