



Fairway Classic is a quality blend of perennial ryegrasses designed for the most discriminating superintendent. The aggressiveness, wear tolerance, dark green color and fine texture of Fairway Classic Perennial Ryegrass Blend offers the highest turf quality under a wide range of agronomic environments.

Characteristics:

- **Fairway Classic** has shown excellent high and low temperature stress tolerance throughout the range of perennial ryegrass adaptation
- **Fairway Classic** provides excellent drought tolerance
- A high endophyte level provides excellent insect resistance in **Fairway Classic**
- Both strong tillering and rooting characteristics in **Fairway Classic** provide a dense turf for increased wear tolerance
- **Fairway Classic** allows for smooth transition from ryegrass to bermudagrass in the spring

Recommended Use:

Golf Courses, Parks, Athletic Fields, and Overseeding Warm Season Turfgrasses

Climatic Zones:

2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (may not be adaptable to all areas within each climatic zone)

Establishment & Maintenance:

Under ideal conditions, germination begins in 6 days. If overseeding, care must be taken to ensure adequate seed to soil contact. Subject to germination rate, first mowing may begin at 21 days after sowing. Recommended mowing heights for tees is 3/8 to 5/8 inch (9.5 – 15.9 mm) 5 to 6 times per week. Recommended mowing height for fairways is 1/2 to 3/4 inch (12.7 – 19.1 mm) 3 to 4 times per week. **Fairway Classic** responds to 1/2 lb Nitrogen per application. Repeat applications only as grass shows need due to fading color.

Seeding Rates:

- Tees and Aprons (Overseeding) 15 - 25 lbs./1000 sq. ft.
(6 1/2 - 11 kg/100 sq meters)
- Fairways (Overseeding) 250 - 400 lbs./acre
(280 – 448 kg/hectare)
- Permanent Turf & Athletic Fields 5 - 20 lbs./1000 sq. ft.
(2 - 9 kgs/100 sq meters)
